### Web Advertising

Recruitment ads can also run in email alerts, as banner ads on journal sites, and on some websites. The Tables of Contents for most publications are emailed to registered users every issue. Emailed Tables of Contents (eTOCs) advertisements are a cost effective method of promoting your position or program. You can run a banner ad at the top or a text ad and website link with an optional logo at the bottom of these alerts.
