Dr. MingMing Ning is Associate Professor of Neurology at Massachusetts General Hospital/Harvard Medical School, where she is Medical Director of the General Neurology Consult Service, Director of the Clinical Proteomics Research Center, and Co-director of the Cardio-Neurology Division. As a board-certified vascular neurologist, Dr. Ning's clinical activities focus on neurovascular disease, with particular interest in strokes related to cardiac abnormalities, and laboratory monitoring of therapeutic efficacy.

Her clinical research, supported by the NIH, utilizes proteomic technology to explore various neurovascular diseases and therapeutic interventions in order to develop novel therapies and biomarkers to improve clinical treatment. She has received awards from the American Heart Association, Howard Hughes Medical Institute, and has been named among America's Top Physicians for her research, mentoring and patient care.

Dr. Ning currently serves on various NIH scientific review panels, Harvard Medical School MPCTI admission committee, MGH Structural Heart Disease/PFO and ECMO committees, various editorial boards and as associate editor for multiple journals. She co-chaired the NIH/NINDS OMICs section of the Stroke Progress Review Group, served as president of the American Federation for Medical Research, and is currently President-Elect of the AFMR Foundation and advisor to the Board of Directors of FASEB.
