

## Travel Award Information for the Molecular Mechanisms of Immune Cell Development and Function Conference

### Application Information and Instructions

The FASEB Molecular Mechanisms of Immune Cell Development and Function Conference supports the participation of students, postdoctoral trainees, and early career faculty at the MMICDF conference by providing partial reimbursement for registration to those who are selected based on their abstract submission and diversity, equity, and inclusion statement.

### How to Apply

Submit:

(1) an abstract (Title, Authors, Author Affiliations, body of abstract).

(2) a letter of intent, such as: "I am applying to the Molecular Mechanisms of Immune Cell Development and Function Conference for a travel award. This application is approved by my mentor (Mentor's name, Title, and Mentor's contact information with email address) (*disregard this sentence if already a faculty member*). I also attest that I will be attending the conference for at least 3 days. If my circumstances change, and I cannot attend the event for at least 3 days, I will immediately notify the organizers (weinmann@uab.edu and bosselur@mail.nih.gov)." The letter of intent should be signed by the applicant.

(3) a statement of no more than 300 words that addresses your experiences in and/or contributions to diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts in science, in your institution, and/or in your community.

**Deadline:** Applications should be received on or before the abstract deadline for the meeting (**June 20, 2022**). Applicants will be notified of the decision as early as possible, but it will likely not be possible to finalize decisions until shortly after the meeting.
