

GRKs and Arrestins 2022 Science Research Conference Travel Award Information

The GRK and Arrestin conference supports the participation of graduate students and postdoctoral trainees by providing full or partial complimentary registration via reimbursement as well as the opportunity to present a short talk and/or poster at the meeting to those who are selected based on their abstract submissions.

How to apply: Submit (1) an abstract (Title, Authors, Institution, body of abstract) and (2) a letter of intent that includes the following information to help guide the decision:

- a. Clearly indicate that you are applying for a travel award to attend the FASEB Scientific Research Conference on GRKs and Arrestins: Key Regulators of GPCR Signal Transduction.
- b. Indicate whether the application has been approved by your mentor (provide Mentor's name, Title, and Mentor's contact information with email address).
- c. Indicate your preference to be considered for a short-talk and poster presentation or a poster presentation.
- d. Indicate your willingness to attend the full-length conference and if your circumstances change, and cannot attend the event for the full duration, you will immediately notify the Fund Committee (SRCTrainee@faseb.org).
- e. Indicate whether you are a member of the American Society of Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics (ASPET)
- f. Indicate whether you consider yourself to be from a group that is underrepresented in science.
- g. Indicate whether there are day care requirements or other special needs that would help reduce the barrier to attend this meeting.
- f. The letter of intent should be signed by the applicant.

Complete applications should be emailed as a single PDF to Adriano Marchese (amarchese@mcw.edu), Sudha Shenoy (sudha.shenoy@duke.edu) and Carsten Hoffmann (carsten.hoffmann@med.uni-jena.de). The applications must be received on or before June 15, 2022, to allow for timely review of applications. Applicants will be notified of the decision at the latest by August 1, 2022. The awardees will receive full or partial complimentary registration, but will have to cover their own travel and lodging costs.
