Who can apply: We will support participation of students, postdoctoral trainees, and junior faculty (3 years or less post completion of their post-doctoral training) in the FASEB Mobile DNA conference by providing partial complimentary registration to those who are selected based on their abstract submissions. Applicants selected to receive the award will be expected to present a poster at the meeting.

How to apply: Submit (1) Name of the applicant, applicant's affiliation, career stage (student, postdoc, or junior faculty), minority status (if applicable), (2) an abstract (Title, Authors, Institution, body of abstract), and (3) a letter of support from the lab director who will be sponsoring applicant's travel (for student and postdoc applicants) or from the applicant (if an applicant is a junior faculty)

"I am supporting a travel award application from my trainee (Trainee's name) applying to attend the 2022 FASEB Mobile DNA conference in Dublin, Ireland. I also attest that my trainee will be attending the conference for at least 3 days. If the circumstances change, and my trainee cannot attend the event for at least 3 days, I will immediately notify the organizers (vperepe@tulane.edu)." The letter of intent should be signed by the mentor (Mentor's name, Title, and Mentor's contact information with email address) or by the applicant (if an applicant is a junior faculty).

The deadline: the applications should be received on or before **April 25th, 2022**, to allow for timely review of applications. Applicants will be notified of the decision by May 1st, 2022. Each awardee will receive \$600 complimentary registration and will have to cover their own travel and lodging costs.
