

## The Noa Noy Memorial Fund Travel Award Instructions

The Noa Noy Memorial Fund supports the participation of students and postdoctoral trainees at the FASEB International Conference on Retinoids by providing **full complimentary registration** (postdoctoral fellows: \$1079, students: \$929) as well as the opportunity to present at the meeting to those who are selected based on their abstract submissions. The awardees will also receive a Noa Noy Memorial Fund Certificate in recognition of their achievements.

How to apply: Students and postdocs should submit (1) an abstract (Title, Authors, Institution, body of abstract) and (2) a letter of intent “I am applying for the Noa Noy Memorial Fund award to attend the 4<sup>th</sup> International FASEB Conference on Retinoids. This application is approved by my mentor (Mentor’s name, Title, and Mentor’s contact information with email address). I also attest that I will be attending the conference for at least 3 days. If my circumstances change, and I cannot attend the event for at least 3 days, I will immediately notify the Fund Committee (SRCTrainee@faseb.org)”. The letter of intent should be signed by the applicant. Complete applications should be emailed to **fasebretinoids@gmail.com**.

The deadline: the applications should be received on or before **April 25th, 2022**, to allow for timely review of applications by the Selection Committee appointed by the Organizers. Applicants will be notified of the decision by May 2nd, 2022. The awardees will receive complimentary registration and will have to cover their own travel and lodging costs.
